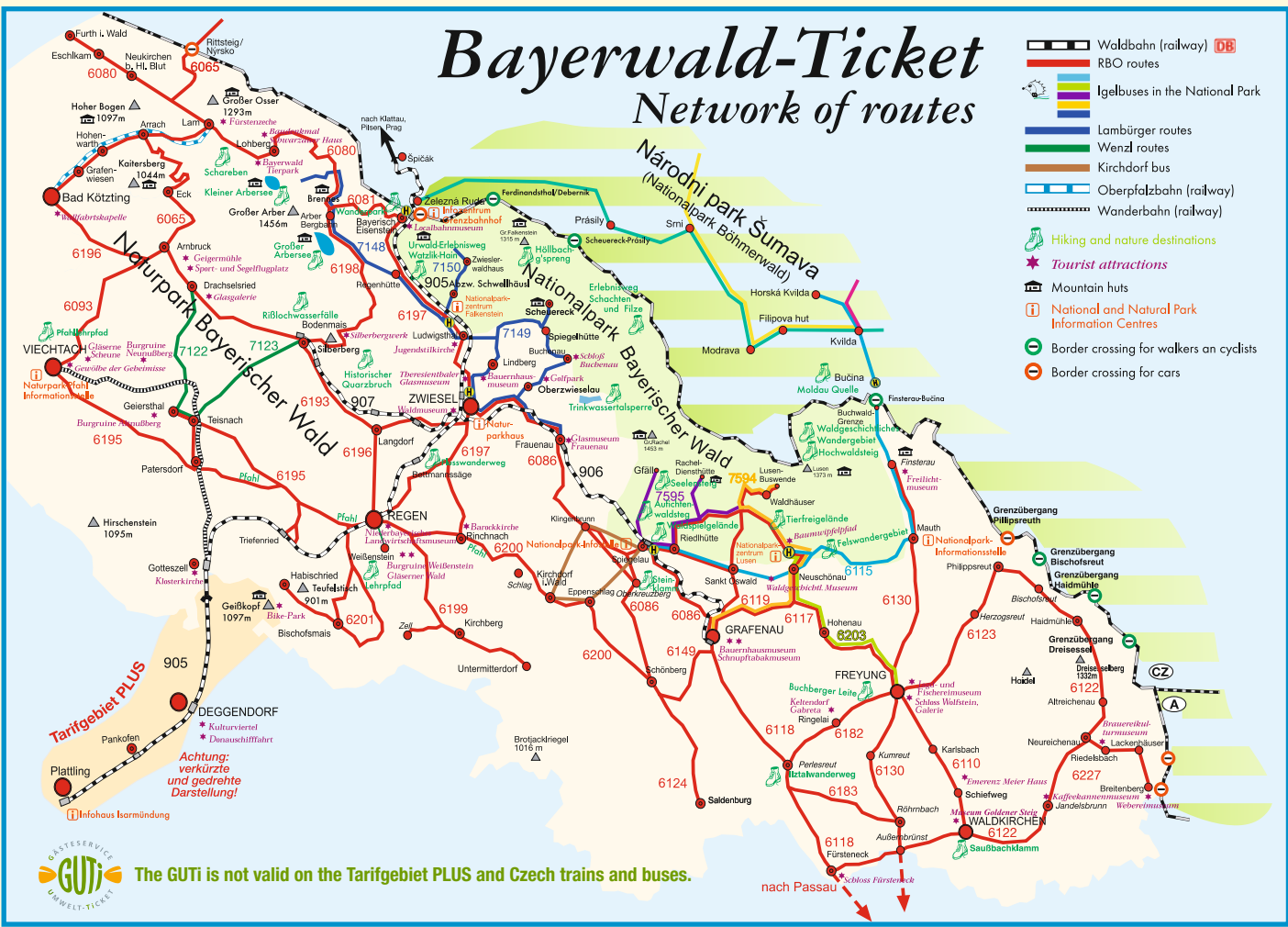

Bayerwald-Ticket

The Combined Ticket for the most important bus and train routes in Bavarian Forest National Park region from €7 for a whole day's travel

NEW from Summer 2010 – free travel in the Bayerwald-Ticket area with the GUTi Guest Card



Tariff regulations:

The Bayerwald-Ticket is offered jointly by the DB Regio AG, RBO Regionalbus Ostbayern GmbH, Regental Bahnbetriebs GmbH and bus companies Lambürger and Wenzl.

It is valid Mondays to Fridays from 08.00 as well as all day on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays

Any 2 children or all children under 15 of the ticket holder are included in the price. Dogs travel free.

Ticket prices: Bayerwald-Ticket €7 per person / day
Bayerwald-Ticket-PLUS €14 per person / day
(for journeys extending to and from Plattling and Deggendorf)

Bicycles are carried free only on the Finsterau Igelbus (6115) and the Oberpfalzbahn (877).

Tickets are sold on all buses and trains of the participating operators, as well as at the station ticket offices and machines and many Tourist Information Offices and accommodation providers.

The normal tariffs of the transportation companies, the Igelbus-Tickets for the National Park buses and the Bayern-Ticket still apply. A price comparison can be worthwhile in certain cases e.g. short journeys, group travel or using a rail card.

In Bavarian dialect, Guti means a 'sweet' and also a small reward. Our ►(GUTi)◄ (Gästeservice Umwelt-Ticket) rewards all visitors travelling in the Bavarian Forest National Park and Natural Park region without a car, thus benefitting the environment. It is easy to reach various walks which have different starting points and destinations. You save on fuel and parking charges and are chauffeured safely and comfortably.

Our ►(GUTi)◄ allows visitors staying in the participating towns and villages to travel by bus and train free of charge. The new ►(GUTi)◄ Guest Card serves as a ticket for unlimited travel on every day of your visit in the whole of the Bayerwald-Ticket area (except the Bayerwald-Ticket-PLUS area and the Green Buses in the Czech Republic).

Ask your accommodation provider about the GUTi!

You will be given your ►(GUTi)◄ -Guest Card when you check in.

How to use the



1. The ►(GUTi)◄ guest card will be issued when you register with your accommodation provider and will be given to you when you arrive.
2. Every visitor (including children) receives a cheque card style guest card.
3. The guest card is valid for the whole of your stay, from arrival until departure. Make sure the card is issued for the correct dates!
4. Put your guest card away safely and always carry it with you – it must be shown when you want to use it for free travel.

5. To be valid for travel, the card must carry the ►(GUTi)◄ -Logo. The logo is in colour on the front and computer generated on the back of the card.
6. The back of the card shows the name of the visitor and the dates of validity of the card, as well as the name and telephone number of the accommodation provider
7. The guest card is only valid for travel in conjunction with an official photo ID.
8. The guest card is valid for the whole Bayerwald-Ticket area with the exception of the Bayerwald-Ticket-PLUS area. It even covers dogs.
9. The tariff and transportation regulations of the individual transportation providers apply. The use of Green Buses in Czech Republic and the transportation of bicycles are not included.
10. Buses and trains in the Bayerwald-Ticket area can be used free of charge Mondays-Fridays from 08.00 and all day Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays.
11. To ensure adequate space, groups of 10 or more are asked to register by phoning 09921/59 68 or contacting regen@rbo.de
